- Complete such training as is required by the officer team. This will include some scheduled training time as well as self-learning, depending on the position for which you will be a volunteer.
- Volunteers must be scheduled.
- Volunteer must check in and out.
- Commitment to be at your post when you are scheduled, or to swap with another volunteer
- Attend scheduled volunteer meetings
- There are no weapons permitted on campus. This includes but is not limited to, guns, knives, swords, mace, brass knuckles, bats, or any other items that could be considered a weapon.
- Sleeping areas are off-limits unless you have special permission for a specific reason.
- If at any time you want to take photos please ask for permission.
- At least one (1) year of sobriety before becoming a volunteer and pass a drug test
- Help with fund-raising activities

Dress Code Policy

NOT permitted

- Halters, tube tops, or spaghetti strap
- Tops that show cleavage or any part of the stomach
- Shirts (t-shirts) with slogans or advertising advocating violence, gangs, drugs, alcohol, rock music, skulls or skeletons, or vulgarity either written or implied
